MORNING DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS - VOLUNTEER HELP NEEDED!

We have noticed a few issues during our morning student drop off. Please remember that parent drivers need to enter from the lower Ross Hill entrance near the smaller church/youth building, drive from the front of the church up through the center of the gravel parking lot along the cones, dropping students off at the crosswalk in the gravel area. Students should then walk through the crosswalk and enter school through the double glass gym doors, and parent drivers continue up through the gravel lot, exiting at the upper Ross Hill exit. School buses are the only vehicles that should be driving up alongside the school building and dropping students off at the crosswalk at the gym doors. If a parent driver needs to park to come into school or talk to someone in the parking lot, please pull up and park near the upper end of the lot, away from the line of traffic for student drop off. **PRESCHOOL PARENTS** should park up towards the office and bring their children through the office doors. **PLEASE NOTE:** If the parking lot is extremely icy, Mr. Wyse will send out a text alert or direct traffic to park down in the lower paved parking lot beside the church as the gravel lot has more trouble with ice. **CROSSING GUARD VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!** It would be extremely helpful if we could have a parent volunteer each morning & afternoon to assist us in being a student crossing guard during the 7:30-8:00am & 2:15-2:45pm timeframes as well as to assist in keeping an eye on the traffic flow and helping to make sure all our students stay alert and stay safe.

TEXT ALERT SERVICE AVAILABLE!

If you wish to be added to our text alert notification service, please provide the office with the cell phone numbers on which you wish to receive the alert. You can either email the office, or write them down and give to the office when you come through. Once submitted, you will receive a text invitation from Mr. Wyse to join. This is the fastest and best method of getting important school information out.
