

### Instrumental Music Lessons

Music lessons will be offered again to students in grades 4-12 this year. Lessons are on a first-com first-serve basis until all spaces are filled.

- Students may sign up for a group instrument lesson on brass, woodwind or limited beginning percussion only. A student taking lessons must be part of a performing group, i.e. band.
- Piano lessons usually are offered privately with a private teacher, contact school for information.
- Lessons will be given usually once a week for approximately one half hour. This time will help in order to accommodate a few students and better group students of like ability together. Your student will also not miss an entire period of class with this type of schedule as well.
- Instruments may be rented from one of several local music stores. They are available for a monthly rental fee which is often applied toward the purchase of the instrument. Ross Corners also owns a few instruments which may be rented. Renter is responsible and liable for all costs incurred in the event of loss or damage to the rented equipment other than ordinary wear and tear.
- The cost of lessons will be determined at the start of each school year. Payments may be added to your tuition bill and paid in installments. If you sign up your student for an instrument lesson a letter will be sent home letting you know positively if your student has a space reserved for lessons. For beginning students a letter with greater details in regards to the music to purchase, which instrument brands are better to look for and other pertinent details will also be included. An e-mail may be sent in lieu of a paper copy.
- Remember, your student will succeed if you help encourage them and be attentive to the amount of their practice time.
